


## ASSEMBLY INSTRUCTIONS



## Una Accent Lamp

Item # KW 3900

### NOTICE:


This light fixture should be installed in accordance with all applicable, local installation codes, and by a person familiar with the construction and operation of it, as well as the hazards involved. Inspect item and contents carefully. If any damage or defect is found, do not install. Retain all packaging material until installation is complete and approved.

1. Carefully remove all parts from the box. Place on a clean, soft surface.
2. For best results fully charge battery before use.
3. Test the lamp.

**Dimmer switch operation:** Touch dimmer (**A**) to adjust between high, medium, low and off settings.

**Charging Instructions:** Charge lamp using provided USB-C cord. Plug located at base.


**NOTE:** For convenience, USB-C to USB-A adapter and charging plug is included.



### Care Instructions:

1. Clean only with a soft dry cloth or feather duster. Do not use abrasive or chemical agents.
2. Battery disposal should be in compliance with any local regulations that address the disposal of hazardous materials and the following or equivalent: "Do not incinerate."
